Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

Let us express our conviction in Allah SWT through faith and obedience, and work hard to avoid what He has forbade us from doing. May we be counted among those of His righteous servants and be rewarded with His blessings.

In conjunction with the Coronation of His Majesty the Fifteenth (15th) Yang Di-Pertuan Agong, His Royal Highness, Sultan Muhammad the Fifth (V), let us together reflect on the sermon



today, entitled, **"His Majesty the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong, the Anchor of Islamic Strength"**.

Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

Leadership is an important aspect in the lives of Muslims. Islam has provided its best guide in determining the nature, characteristics and criteria of leadership, which clearly illustrates how Islam has placed leadership as something which relates closely to the *syariat*, as guided by revelations received from Allah SWT. Allah SWT declared in Surah al-Baqarah, verse 30:

وَإِذْ قَالَ رَبُّكَ لِلْمَلٰٓئِكَةِ اِنِّىْ جَاعِلٌ فِى الْاَرْضِ خَلِيْفَةً قَالُوْۤا اَجْعَلْ فِىْهَا مَنْ يُّفْسِدُ فِىْهَا وَيَسْفِكُ الدِّمَآءَ وَنَحْنُ نُسَبِّحُ بِحَمْدِكَ وَنُقَدِّسُ لَكَ قَالَ اِنِّىْۤ اَعْلَمُ مَا لَا تَعْلَمُوْنَ ﴿۳۰﴾

Which means: *"Behold, the Lord said to the angels: "I will create a vicegerent on earth." They said: "Will You place therein one who will make mischief therein and shed blood? - whilst we do celebrate Your praises and glorify Your holy (name)?" He said: "I know what you know not."*

A system of government based on constitutional monarchy moulded through the practice of harmonious democracy is the way of our beloved country, Malaysia. It results in a diverse nation made up of different religions, races, tribes, languages, and backgrounds, united under the rule of His Majesty, The Yang Di-Pertuan Agong, a symbol of supreme power of the country's constitution. This clearly proves that the sovereignty of the nation, which is anchored in Islam, unites the people under the auspices of His Majesty, The Yang Di-Pertuan Agong. This is the uniqueness and beauty of Islam as a religion of mercy and peace.

Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

According to the history of the Malay World, when a king converts to Islam, all his people would follow suit and Islam would be declared the official religion of the country. A king is considered the seat of power for the propagation and spread of Islam. As a result, today we



can see that article 3 (2) of the Constitution states that The Yang di-Pertuan Agong is the head of Islam for the Federation and the states which have no sultan, namely Penang, Sarawak, Sabah, Melaka and the Federal Territories. In the other states, the head of Islam there would be the Sultan of that particular State. The Yang di-Pertuan Agong and the Sultans as heads of Islam are considered very special to our country. Therefore, The Yang di-Pertuan Agong's election as head of state and religion requires the shouldering of a very heavy burden of responsibility. This can be heard during His Majesty's pronouncement of the oath of office, which includes the phrases *Wallahi, Wabillahi, Watallahi* which are then elaborated through keywords such as law, the Federal Constitution, Islam, fairness and peace.

In Islam, a leader of the community acts as a representative of the people, who are all referred to as the vicegerent of Allah SWT, entrusted to carry out His commands on this earth. One of our obligations as His vicegerent is to spread the fundamental teachings of Islam, which is that of a religion that spreads blessings to all mankind. Among the blessings that should be spread is fairness among fellow human beings, as well as not being hateful, cruel, oppressive, committing fraud or being selective with others based on their rank or status. Efforts to ensure justice is practiced over all mankind and is considered part of conviction, as declared by Allah SWT in Surah an-Nahl, verse 90:

وَالْبَغْيِ يَعِظُكُمْ لَعَلَّكُمْ تَذَكَّرُونَ ﴿٩٠﴾

Which means: “Allah commands justice, the doing of good, and liberality to kith and kin, and He forbids all shameful deeds, and injustice and rebellion: He instructs you, that you may receive admonition.”

Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

The strength of Islam in our nation, which flows through His Majesty the Yang di-Pertuan Agong may be see in the implementation of Islam in this country, which is based on the



principle of *Wasatiyyah* (moderation). In essence, *Wasatiyyah* refers to the wise and balanced implementation of Islam to ensure that it does not oppress or be unjust towards other races and religions, which at the same time ensures Islam continues to be respected and defended. Therefore, it is our duty to obey His Majesty the Yang Di-Pertuan Agong. As stated by Rasulullah SAW in a hadith recorded by Imam al-Bukhari and narrated by Nafi 'bin' Abdillah RA:

السَّمْعُ وَالطَّاعَةُ عَلَى الْمَرْءِ الْمُسْلِمِ فِيمَا أَحَبَّ وَكَرِهَ مَا لَمْ يُؤْمَرْ بِمَعْصِيَةٍ فَإِذَا أُمِرَ بِمَعْصِيَةٍ
فَلَا سَمْعَ وَلَا طَاعَةَ

Which means: *"It is mandatory to listen and obey Muslim leaders in favourable and unfavourable matters as long as it is not to commit evil, but when ordered to do evil, do not listen or obey it."*

Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

The conclusions that can be derived from the sermon today are as follows:

- First:** Islam places leadership at the highest position in the religion as it leads people to attain the pleasure of Allah SWT in this world and the hereafter.
- Second:** Every leader must have a strong faith, because without faith and conviction, leadership will wane and lose the blessings of Allah SWT.
- Third:** We must always strive to be the best citizen! If we are a leader, we must strive to be the best leader! People and leaders who are good role models tend to lead the community towards excellence.

As declared by Allah SWT in Surah al-A'raaf, verse 96:

Which means: “If the people of the towns had but believed and feared Allah, We should indeed have opened out to them (All kinds of) blessings from heaven and earth; but they rejected (the truth), and We brought them to book for their misdeeds.”
