### Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

The year 2017 will soon come to an end. A new year will be upon us soon and with it, the hope that our practices and acts of worship in the year that has passed are accepted by the Creator of the Worlds. Strengthen our conviction and our faith by obeying all of Allah SWT's commands and avoiding all that He has prohibited. Let us realise that we are not only pursuing success in this world, but also a greater success in the Hereafter.



Let us reflect upon today's sermon entitled, **"This Life as a Bridge to the Afterlife"**.

**Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,**

We are aware that this life is only temporary. This world will not last forever. Only the Hereafter is eternal. Imagine the loss for the person who only pursues pleasures of this world, when all of it shall perish. Therefore, do not be fooled by this world, beautifully decorated for the eyes, but will eventually lead to nowhere.

For those who are rushing in pursuit of this world, they are just like those who are absorbed in a game. This parable has been described by Allah SWT in Surah Al-An'am, verse 32:

وَمَا الْحَيَاةُ الدُّنْيَا إِلَّا لَعِبٌ وَلَهْوٌ وَلِلدَّارِ الْآخِرَةِ خَيْرٌ لِلَّذِينَ يَتَّقُونَ أَفَلَا تَعْقِلُونَ ﴿٣٢﴾

**Which means:** *“And the worldly life is not but amusement and diversion; but the home of the Hereafter is best for those who fear Allah, so will you not reason?”*

**Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,**

We gain an immortal life only in the Hereafter. Therefore, live like a traveller, stopping once in a while in this world to collect provisions throughout our travel. The journey to the Hereafter is still a long one. The best provision for the Hereafter is our conviction in Allah SWT. Imam al-Bukhari recorded a hadith narrated by Abdullah bin Umar R.A, where Rasulullah SAW was reported to have said:

كُنْ فِي الدُّنْيَا كَأَنَّكَ غَرِيبٌ أَوْ عَابِرُ سَبِيلٍ



**Which means:** *“Be in this world as if you were a stranger or a traveller along the path.”*

Therefore, let us reflect upon some of the things that can ensure our wellbeing in the hereafter, which include the following:

**First:** Reflect about where we come from. Indeed, our existence on this earth is due to the mercy and love of Allah SWT. Allah SWT declared in Surah Al-Mukminun, verses 12 to 14:

وَلَقَدْ خَلَقْنَا الْإِنْسَانَ مِنْ سُلَالَةٍ مِنْ طِينٍ ﴿١٢﴾ ثُمَّ جَعَلْنَاهُ نُطْفَةً فِي قَرَارٍ مَكِينٍ ﴿١٣﴾ ثُمَّ  
خَلَقْنَا النُّطْفَةَ عَلَقَةً فَخَلَقْنَا الْعَلَقَةَ مُضْغَةً فَخَلَقْنَا الْمُضْغَةَ عِظْمًا فَكَسَوْنَا  
الْعِظْمَ لَحْمًا ثُمَّ أَنْشَأْنَاهُ خَلْقًا آخَرَ ﴿١٤﴾ فَتَبَارَكَ اللَّهُ أَحْسَنُ الْخَالِقِينَ

**Which means:** *“And certainly did We create man from an extract of clay. Then We placed him as a sperm-drop in a firm lodging. Then We made the sperm-drop into a clinging clot, and We made the clot into a lump [of flesh], and We made [from] the lump, bones, and We covered the bones with flesh; then We developed him into another creation. So blessed is Allah, the best of creators.”*

Therefore, after realizing the fact that we were created by Allah SWT, we should be grateful and love Allah SWT more than anything else.

**Second:** Reflect on our purpose in this world. Allah SWT did not create humans in vain. We have the responsibility to Allah SWT to fulfil His right, by only worshipping Him and to perform all that He has



commanded us to do, and to avoid all that He has prohibited us from doing.

Meanwhile, our responsibilities towards mankind is stated in a hadith recorded by Imam Muslim Rahimahullah, and narrated by Abu Hurairah RA, where Rasulullah SAW was reported to have said:

لَا تَحَاسَدُوا وَلَا تَنَاجَشُوا وَلَا تَبَاغَضُوا وَلَا تَدَابَرُوا، وَلَا يَبِعْ بَعْضُكُمْ عَلَى بَيْعِ بَعْضٍ، وَكُونُوا عِبَادَ اللَّهِ إِخْوَانًا، الْمُسْلِمُ أَخُو الْمُسْلِمِ، لَا يَظْلِمُهُ وَلَا يَخْذُلُهُ وَلَا يَحْقِرُهُ، التَّقْوَى هَاهُنَا، وَيُشِيرُ إِلَى صَدْرِهِ ثَلَاثَ مَرَّاتٍ، بِحَسْبِ امْرِئٍ مِنَ الشَّرِّ أَنْ يَحْقِرَ أَخَاهُ الْمُسْلِمَ، كُلُّ الْمُسْلِمِ عَلَى الْمُسْلِمِ حَرَامٌ، دَمُهُ وَمَالُهُ وَعَرَضُهُ.

**Which means:** *“Do not envy one another, and do not inflate prices for one another, and do not hate one another, and do not turn away from one another, and do not undercut one another in trade, but [rather] be slaves of Allah and brothers [amongst yourselves]. A Muslim is the brother of a Muslim: he does not oppress him, nor does he fail him, nor does he lie to him, nor does he hold him in contempt. Taqwa (piety) is right here [and he pointed to his chest three times]. It is evil enough for a man to despise his Muslim brother. The whole of a Muslim is inviolable for another Muslim: his blood, his property, and his honour.”*

Therefore, if we commit mistakes against others, be quick to apologize and fix the broken or fractured relationship. Remember, everything will be assessed on the Day of Judgement.

**Third:** Reflect on whether our provisions for the Hereafter are enough. The moment we are left alone in the grave, we will be questioned by the



angels. After that, we shall be resurrected on the Day of Judgement for our deeds on earth to be judged. Only then shall all our good deeds and failings in this world be exposed. Allah SWT reminded us through Surah Al-Isra', verse 21:

أَنْظُرْ كَيْفَ فَضَّلْنَا بَعْضَهُمْ عَلَى بَعْضٍ ۚ وَلِلْآخِرَةِ أَكْبَرُ دَرَجَاتٍ وَأَكْبَرُ تَفْضِيلًا ﴿٢١﴾

**Which means:** *“Look how We have favoured [in provision] some of them over others. But, the Hereafter is greater in degrees [of difference] and greater in distinction.”*

Therefore, make haste in performing good deeds, with the hope that in the Hereafter, the good deeds will be on our side as our defenders, and accompany us to the paradise that we have been yearning for.

#### **Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,**

To end the sermon today, the *mimbar* would like to again remind the congregation on the takeaways we should learn from:

**First:** A person who looks for true devotion and conviction shall always be self-righteous, and assess where his position is, whether he is on the blessed path of Allah SWT, or otherwise.

**Second:** Death and the Day of Judgement should be motivation enough for a servant of Allah SWT to ponder and reflect upon his life in this world.



**Third:** Reflect on the commands and prohibitions of Allah SWT that we have committed to, and improve our relationship with others.

As declared by Allah SWT in the Al-Quran through Surah Al-Hasyr, verse 18.

**Which means:** “O you who have believed, fear Allah. And let every soul look to what it has put forth for tomorrow - and fear Allah. Indeed, Allah is acquainted with what you do.”
