How fortunate indeed for us to live in peace and prosperity, which is the grace and blessings bestowed upon us by Allah SWT.
Accordingly, the khatib today will discuss the sermon entitled "The Call of
Peace for AII".
Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
The world today is shocked and appalled by the acts of terrorism and
violence occurring everywhere. The tragedy of the Iraq invasion and
occupation, attacks on Palestinians, shootings in France, bombings in
Indonesia, Turkey and Bangladesh, and the recent bombing in the holy
month of Ramadhan at the an-Nabawi Mosque in Madinah, are tragedies
devastating to our souls.
Such events are becoming more and more common, as if without any end in
sight. Worse still, the western media is taking advantage by associating all
these violence to the teachings of Islam, which is fuelling the 'Islamophobia'
virus in the world community.
Thus, Muslims around the world should not be silent and mute. If we do not
respond or act, we may be accused of supporting terrorism. Ultimately, we
are trapped and are unable to be defenders of Islam. Muslims should rise
up and speak the truth: that violence is not part of the teachings, or way, of
Islam. In fact, they are actions that contradict human nature and are actually
driven by lust and desire.
Surah al-Baqarah, in verse 213 of the Al-Quran, which was read by the
khatib earlier, clearly states this. Allah SWT declared:
Which means: "Mankind was [of] one religion [before their deviation]; then
Allah sent the prophets as bringers of good tidings and warnings and sent
down with them the Book in truth to judge between the people concerning
that in which they differed. And none differed over the Book except those
who were given it - after the clear proofs came to them - out of jealous
animosity among themselves. And Allah guided those who believed to the



	truth concerning that over which they had differed, by His permission. And
	Allah guides whom He wills to a straight path."
	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
13	Any form of violence is rejected by all religions, especially Islam. In fact, the
	life and teachings of Rasulullah SAW did not promote Islam through
	violence. Rasulullah SAW's message was fairness and justice among
	humanity, and against tyranny.
	These were the goals of all the Prophets, as stated by Allah SWT in Surah
14	Yunus, verse 47:
	وَلِكُلِّ أُمَّةٍ رَّسُولُكُ فَإِذَا جَكَآءَ رَسُولُهُمْ قُضِي بَيْنَهُم بِٱلْقِسْطِ وَهُمْ لَا يُظْلَمُونَ الْ
	Which means: "To every people (was sent) a messenger: when their
15	messenger comes (before them), the matter will be judged between them
	with justice, and they will not be wronged."
	As the final Messenger sent to mankind, the call by Rasulullah SAW is
	universal and relevant at all times until the Day of Resurrection. If it is true
4.0	that the religion of Islam advocates violence and injustice, it would not have
16	spread to all corners of the world and would not have a place in the human
	heart, because it would conflict with nature. The allegation that Islam
	encourages violence is just baseless slander.
17	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	Rasulullah SAW, his Companions R.A, and the many generations after
	them have fulfilled their roles and responsibilities in the spreading of Islam
	as a religion of peace, mercy and fairness. It is not created out of fiction or
	myth. It is reality and is savoured by Muslims today.
18	Realising this, we, as Muslims, should also play our role as representatives
	in calling for good and forbidding evil. Acts of violence and tyranny against
	humanity are part of this evil which should be stopped.
19	This is the call of Allah SWT in Surah Ali 'Imran, verse 104;

	Which means: "Let there arise out of you a band of people inviting to all
20	that is good, enjoining what is right, and forbidding what is wrong: Those will
	be the successful."
	According to Dr. Wahbah al-Zuhayli, this is a command to Muslims as a
21	whole, because it is impossible to do individually. This is the true role of
	Muslims. Inaction is not the right choice. In fact, inaction can harm Islam.
	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	Islam recognizes the rights that exist in every human being, such as the
	right to possessions, families and especially the right to life. Therefore,
22	human life is precious in Islam. A life cannot be taken arbitrarily without
	reasons allowed by the Shariat and the law. It is not limited only to Muslims,
	but also to non-Muslims.
	This is stated in the hadith by Rasulullah SAW, as narrated by Abdullah bin
	Amr R.A and recorded by Imam al-Bukhari R.H.:

	مَنْ قَتَلَ مُعَاهَدًا لَمْ يَرِحْ رَائِحَةَ الْجُنَّةِ وَإِنَّ رِيحَهَا تُوجَدُ مِنْ مَسِيرَةِ أَرْبَعِينَ عَامًا
	Which means: "Those who fight (kill) mu'ahad (non-Muslims who have
24	made an agreement not to fight), shall not smell the fragrance of Paradise
	though its fragrance can be smelt at a distance of forty years (of traveling)."
	This is the true meaning of Islam, as it is spread around the world with the
25	aim of imparting peace and prosperity for mankind to live in this world and in
	the hereafter, and not otherwise.
	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
26	To end today's sermon, let us ponder upon these conclusions as guidance
	for all of us.



Living in peace is a form of blessing from Allah SWT which First:

must be appreciated by every human being.

Second: The accusation that Islam is a religion of violence is totally

false.

Third: Muslims must rise up and act to spread Islam, as well as to

convey a message of peace to the world community.

Allah SWT declared in Surah Al 'Imran, verse 110:

كُنتُمْ خَيْرَ أُمَّةٍ أُخْرِجَتَ لِلنَّاسِ تَأْمُرُونَ بِٱلْمَعْرُوفِ وَتَنْهَوْنَ عَنِ ٱلْمُنكِرِ وَتُؤْمِنُونَ بِٱللَّهِ ۗ وَلَوْ ءَامَكَ أَهْلُ ٱلْكِتَابِ لَكَانَ خَيْرًا لَهُمَّ مِنْهُمُ ٱلْمُؤْمِنُوك وَأَكُثُرُهُمُ ٱلْفَسِقُونَ اللهُ

Which means: "You are the best of peoples, evolved for mankind, enjoining what is right, forbidding what is wrong, and believing in Allah. If only the People of the Book had faith, it were best for them: among them are some who have faith, but most of them are perverted transgressors."
