Strengthen the conviction within ourselves, with the drive and determination to perform all that has been commanded by Allah SWT and to avoid all that He has prohibited. May the firmness of conviction embodied within us assure our safety and success in this world and in the hereafter.		



	On this blessed Friday, the khatib would like to invite the congregation to
8	jointly reflect upon a sermon entitled, "Steadfast in Practicing the
	Sunnah".
	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
9	Indeed, the arrival of Rasulullah SAW was the greatest gift of Allah SWT
	upon mankind. There is no better role model to follow than him. We should
	emulate his personality, character and mannerisms in our daily life. It is true
	that there are many leaders in this world whom we can idolise, but do they
	all have the quality of character and personality like him? Of course, the
	answer is <i>no</i> .
	Even in the book entitled "100 Most Influential Persons in History"
	written by Michael H. Hart, the Prophet Muhammad SAW has been placed
10	at the number one position. This clearly shows that Rasulullah SAW is the
10	best and most special person among all human beings. Not only was he
	able to change people, but he was also able change the world after his
	death.
	Therefore, let us strive to emulate the way of life of Rasulullah SAW by
	practicing what he had carried out and performed in his life, in terms of
11	worship, manners or even Islamic attitude, in order to achieve the pleasures
	and graces of Allah SWT.
	This coincides with the words of Allah SWT in Surah Al-Ahzab verse 21:

	Which means: "You have indeed, in the Messenger of Allah, a beautiful
13	pattern (of conduct) for any one whose hope is in the graces and blessings
	of Allah and the Final Day, and who engages much in the Praise of Allah."
14	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	Among the most favoured deeds, or Sunnah, of Rasulullah SAW is the



	Tahajjud prayers. It is one of the voluntary prayers performed by Rasulullah
	SAW that we are very much encouraged to perform. This prayer is
	performed with a minimum of 2 rakaats, or more than 2 rakaats if able to.
	Come, let us constantly perform the Tahajjud prayers, up to the point that
15	we will regret not performing it. Sacrifice some sleep at night in order to be
	awarded a high position and to receive priceless rewards from Allah SWT.
	as mentioned in Surah Al-Isra' verse 79:
16	وَمِنَ ٱلَّيْلِ فَتَهَجَّدْ بِهِ عَنَافِلَةً لَّكَ عَسَى آن يَبْعَثَكَ رَبُّكَ مَقَامًا تَحْمُودًا الله
	Which means: "And pray in the small hours of the morning: (it would be) an
	additional prayer (or spiritual profit) for you: soon will your Lord raise you to
	a Station of Praise and Glory!"
	The Dhuha prayer does not necessarily have to take place in the mosque or
	mussola. We can perform it in the office or at work before starting the day's
17	work. It only takes 5 minutes to perform and will not interfere with the
	productivity of our work. Furthermore, the Dhuha prayer has a remarkably
	good virtue,
	as told in the hadith Qudsi recorded by Imam Abu Daud rahimahullah and
	narrated by Nu'aym bin Hammar RA, where Rasulullah SAW was reported
40	to have said:

	Which means: "Allah SWT said: 'Sons of Adam, do not fail in performing
19	four rak`ahs in the beginning of the day (the time of Dhuha) as it will be
	sufficient for the latter part of the day."
	Which means: "Allah SWT said: 'Sons of Adam, do not fail in performing
20	four rak`ahs in the beginning of the day (the time of Dhuha) as it will be
	sufficient for the latter part of the day."
21	Based on the hadith above, the voluntary <i>Dhuha</i> prayers is likened to a key



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that will open the eagerly awaited door of sustenance. Therefore, let us make the *Dhuha* prayers a daily practice in order for the sustenance we receive be increased with the permission of Allah SWT.

Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

Rasulullah SAW was also fond of voluntary fasting. One of the voluntary fasts practiced by Rasulullah SAW was the Three (3) Day fast perfomed every thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth day of every Hijri month. This is also known as the White Days Fast (*Yaum al-Bidh*). Rasulullah SAW had also fast on Mondays and Thursdays, on the day of *Arafah* (which is on 9th of ZulHijjah), on the day of *Ashura* (which is on 10th of Muharram) and Six Days in Shawwal.

Indeed, there are many hadith that explains the advantages of voluntary fasts mentioned above. Among the hadiths that explain the virtues of fasting three days in each month, is the hadith recorded by Imam Al-Bukhari and narrated by 'Abdullah bin' Amr bin Al-Aas, where Rasulullah SAW was reported to have said:

صَوْمُ ثَلاَثَةِ أَيَّامٍ صَوْمُ الدَّهْرِ كُلِّهِ

Which means: "Whoever fasts three days every month it is as if he had fast all his life.

Such is the reward to be gained by those who fast as practiced by Rasulullah SAW. Therefore, let us train ourselves to perform voluntary fasting in order to obtain as many rewards as possible from Allah SWT.

Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

Be aware that Rasulullah SAW also emphasized on the practice of asking for forgiveness through *istighfar* on a daily basis. Although Rasulullah SAW was a man above any wrongdoing and safeguarded from committing any sin or error, he still made the practice of asking for forgiveness a routine in his daily life.
