7	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,  On this auspicious day, let us together nurture the faith and conviction within us by carrying out the commands of Allah SWT, and by casting aside what He has prohibited. Indeed, the best provisions for us for our journey to the Hereafter is a good supply of conviction and faith.  The 1st of February in each year has been chosen as Federal Territories Day,
	to commemorate the formation of the Federal Territory 43 years ago.



8	Accordingly, the sermon today will touch on the topic, "Pleasant City,
	Properous Citizens".
9	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	As citizens of Malaysia, we must surely dream of achieving prosperity and
	security in this nation. But we wonder, what are the types of auspicious
	elements which should exist within a nation? What are the characteristics
	associated with them?
10	A description of the auspicious elements of a nation and its residents have
	been explained by Allah SWT in Sura Saba ', verse 18:
	وَجَعَلْنَا بَيْنَهُمْ وَبَيْنَ ٱلْقُرَى ٱلَّتِي بَارَكْنَا فِيهَا قُرِّى ظَاهِرَةً وَقَدَّرْنَا فِيهَا ٱلسَّايَر ۖ سِيرُواْ
	فِيهَا لَيَـالِي وَأَيَّامًا ءَامِنِينَ اللَّهُ
	Which means: "Between them and the Cities on which We had poured our
11	blessings, We had placed Cities in prominent positions, and between them
' '	We had appointed stages of journey in due proportion: "Travel therein,
	secure, by night and by day."
	According to Ibnu Kathir rahimahullah, this verse tells what the residents of a
	city receives in the form of pleasure, luxury, peace and prosperity as well as
	the towns nearby where the plants and fruits are in abundance, so that
12	travellers can rest and stay in such prosperous city. Praise be to Allah SWT,
	for if we realise, most of these favours and blessings of Allah SWT have
	already been received by us today.
	Therefore, we should be thankful to Allah SWT and at the same time request
	that these favours be maintained, or even increased, in the future. Of course,
13	the best displays of gratitude should be followed by observations of practices
	and supplications to Allah SWT, which includes making efforts to maintain
	peace and harmony by following the guidance given by Allah SWT.
14	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	A city or a town is a place with a high number of people, as well as containing
	central administrative institutions and economic activities, and Islam



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encourages for such city or town to be developed. City life should be based on the al-Quran and as-Sunnah. With that, Muslims shall be able to produce a variety of political, economic and social institutions which could help them to become a civil society.

A noble and good leadership is also a key element in securing the prosperity of a nation. In the Federal Territories, for example, we are grateful and fortunate enough to be blessed with able leaders, especially His Majesty the Yang DiPertuan Agong, who shoulders the responsibility of being the head of religious affairs of our nation. With His Majesty's excellent personal morals, affinity to the people and magnanimity, he should be a good example for every citizen to emulate. A leader with strong religious soul and heart is a precious gift from Allah SWT to the people.

## Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,

In an effort to strengthen and develop the city and the nation we love, there are some fundamental matters that form the basic requirements that we must pay attention to. One important issue to note is the inability to own an affordable houses and the difficulty of finding a place to stay. This happens especially among the younger generation who have just begun their careers and are in the early stages of married life.

Financial constraints with various commitments contributes to making the situation worse. As a result, there is an uneven distribution of population with the existence of illegal squatters and slums, the spread of epidemics, uncleanness and unhygienic conditions, and so on. This should not be taken lightly and must be solved immediately.

In fact, efforts towards solving problems that exist within the city have been carried out from time to time. To address the issue of citizens unable to afford houses of their own, for example, the Federal Territories Ministry has taken the initiative to build affordable houses under the Federal Territories Affordable Homes ((RUMAWIP) programme. This would ensure low and middle income citizens can afford to own a house. What remains to be seen is our sensitivity to volunteer assisting the authorities in addressing this matter.



	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
19	The next thing that should be considered is the efforts to unite the people,
	especially Muslims. Disunity and divisions in the Muslim community should
	be avoided, especially in our quest to create a prosperous Federal Territory.
	These efforts require a continuous process of education and the role largely
	played by institutions such as mosques.
20	Therefore, Muslims are urged to be level-headed, by avoiding the practice of
	partisan politics in mosques. The mosque is actually an institution to unite the
	people, and not otherwise. Any <i>da'wah</i> effort that adopts an astute approach
	will increase the number of visitors and add to the congregration.
	Similarly, outside the mosque, people should adopt a moderate, wise and
	level-headed attitude towards politics. Being too extreme or blindly following
21	others would lead to a fragmented society as well as exposing the immaturity
	of its citizens. In order to avoid discord, dissent or political differences,
	Muslims need to adopt a tolerant attitude and respect for others.
22	This recommendation comes from Allah SWT, through Surah al-Nur, verse 22.

	Which means: "Let not those among you who are endued with grace and
	amplitude of means resolve by oath against helping their kinsmen, those in
23	want, and those who have left their homes in Allah's cause: let them forgive
	and overlook, do you not wish that Allah should forgive you? For Allah is Oft-
	Forgiving, Most Merciful."
24	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	Inviting towards good and preventing evil is a religious obligation, either by
	an individual or a leader. Disobedience and vice among citizens should be
	prevented from continuing to spread. Thus, citizens of the Federal Territories
	should cooperate in the Operation to Curb Illegal Activities (or OPS BAH) run



	by the government. The effort aims to combat vice activities, gambling and so
	on.
25	Another factor that should be brought to the attention of the citizens is the
	issue of homeless people. Society should play its role in helping the homeless
	through proper channels. Additionally, they should be given encouragement
	and be made aware of more comfortable and proper accommodations, such
	as the Homeless Transit Centre.
	Similarly, begging and vagrancy activities which are prevalent around
	eateries is unhealthy and is becoming prevalent in recent years. It has given
	a bad image to our country. Accordingly, the general public must also play its
26	role in eradicating such begging activities. This awareness must be spread to
	all so that the Federal Territory shall remain cheerful and pleasant for
	everyone.
	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	The main issue that should be addressed together by all inhabitants of the
0.7	Federal Territories is the issue of cleanliness of the cities and also the towns
27	surrounding them. Among the areas of focus are food stalls, night markets,
	farmers' markets, daily markets and so on. It implicitly reflects the level of
	consciousness, thinking, attitude and culture of the inhabitants.
	Thus, appropriate action should be taken by every citizen to ensure that the
28	Federal Territories are clean and prosperous. Isn't maintaining cleanliness
	and purity a religious requirement?
	Imam al-Bukhari rahimahullah recorded a narration by 'Alqamah bin Abdillah
	RA, where Rasulullah SAW was reported to have said:
29	حَيَّ عَلَى الطَّهُورِ الْمُبَارَكِ وَالْبَرَكَةُ مِنْ اللَّهِ
	Which means: "Come towards cleanliness with all the blessings and the
	blessings come (only) from Allah"
30	Fellow Muslims blessed by Allah,
	To end today's sermon, the <i>khatib</i> would like to present some conclusions for
	us to reflect upon, and to use as provisions for our journey to the Hereafter:



First: The prosperity and tranquillity of the Federal Territories are graces and blessings from Allah SWT. Second: The basics of urban development is to invite people towards good and to prevent what is wrong. Third: The community and the authorities should be united in efforts to maintain peace and harmony in the Federal Territories. Allah SWT declared in Surah al-Nahl, verse 112: رَبُ ٱللَّهُ مَثَلًا قَرْيَةً كَانَتُ ءَامِنَةً مُّطْمَيِنَّةً يَأْتِيهَا رِزْقُهَا رَغَدًا مِّن كُلِّ مَكَانِ كَفَرَتْ بِأَنْعُمِ ٱللَّهِ فَأَذَ قَهَا ٱللَّهُ لِبَاسَ ٱلْجُوعِ وَٱلْخَوْفِ بِمَا كَانُواْ Which means: "Allah sets forth a Parable: a city enjoying security and quiet, abundantly supplied with sustenance from every place: Yet was it ungrateful for the favours of Allah: so Allah made it taste of hunger and terror (in 32 extremes) (closing in on it) like a garment (from every side), because of the (evil) which (its people) wrought." بَارَكَ اللهُ لِيْ وَلَكُمْ بِالْقَرْآنِ الْعَظِيْمِ وَنَفَعَنِي وَإِيَّاكُمْ بِمَا فِيْهِ مِنَ الآيَاتِ وَالذِّكْرِ ا وَتَقَبَّلَ مِنِّي وَمِنْكُمْ تِلاَوَتَهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ السَّمِيعُ الْعَلِيمُ. أَقُوْلُ قَوْلِيْ هَذَا وَأَسْتَغْفِرُ اللهَ الْعَظِ لِيْ وَلَكُمْ وَلِسَائِرِ الْمُسْلِمِيْنَ وَالْمُسْلِمَاتِ وَالْمُؤْمِنِيْنَ وَالْمُؤْمِنَاتِ الأَحْيَاءِ مِنْهُمْ وَالأَمْوَات فَاسْتَغْفِرُوْهُ إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْغَفُوْرُ الرَّحِيمُ.
